Summary of Project

The work took around two and a half years to complete and used in the region of a thousand tonnes of Lakeland slate. There is an extensive boundary wall, some of which is retaining in parts, a large Gothic archway and five matching circular pillars. Elegant bespoke metal railings compliment the stonework around the perimeter. Within the garden are sets of steps, a circular walled garden and other sections of wall incorporating corners, curves and returns, all reflecting the exceptional quality of workmanship demonstrated throughout the project. The metalwork was produced by Chris Brammall.
